The four day program is designed to help young people explore the many career options available in rural industry. TASTE gives students an appreciation of the practical skills and innovative technology used across a wide range of agricultural careers.

"After two days of passing barren country side of Queensland and dodging roos and pigs I was finally there. My week began with practicing cattle drafting, followed by some shearing, wood working, horse riding and one of my favourites, motorbike riding. Coming from the outer suburbs of Brisbane meant that I hadn't had much exposure to cows, sheep, horses or motorbikes. I thought I would be the only one that came from the suburbs but I wasn't. That's why I loved this experience so much because I got to meet people that had the same interests no matter where they came from in Australia."

What will you do at TASTE?
