

CMEWeb(Online Library Catalogue)

What is it?

- CMEWeb is an online library catalogue that is accessible <u>anywhere</u> there is internet access...
- Desktop computers
- Laptop computers
- Tablets (both apple and android)
- Mobile phones
- iPods (etc)

How do I get there?

 On the bottom of our school webpage there is a link. Click on the link and you will be taken to our CME Web.




What will I find?

- As soon as the page opens you will see our school logo at the top and the search field under the Library Search heading.
- This page is where you will search for the things you want.



How do I search?



- To find information you use the pink (ready), yellow (set) and green (go) search boxes.
- Click on the down arrow of the pink box to change the search to a Title, Author, Series, etc. search.



 Click on the down arrow of the yellow box to "words containing" OR "words beginning with"




Type your search term into the green box.




Inclusivity

- When typing in a search, a drop down box appears, to enhance the user's search.
- The user need only type the first few letters of a word to find the resource.
- This will work for all searches except ALL!



Let's search for sheep....


- As soon as you start typing, results come up.
- The more you type the closer you get to your topic



- You will then get a list of subjects from your catalogue.
- Click on the subject which best suits your search



- This topic has many resources and books in the library.
- If you double click on the title, the information for the book or resource will be displayed (including a short reference for the book!)



Reserving a book.

 To reserve a book that you have found in your search, you double click on the title. (we will reserve Agnes the sheep in this search)

- You will then get a reservation box open in the middle of the screen.
- Click on "Reserve Item"



- A Reservation Request window will open.
- Add your name and email address and click "Reserve Now" (No password is needed)
- An e-mail will be sent to your library staff and the item or items will be sent out in your next mail.

What if it's not in your Library????

- Even if you ask for help with an obscure topic (one that does not have resources in your Library) we can still assist.
- The GoTo box becomes orange and still has links for you to follow.



GoTo Links....

- GoTo links are set up to 'Go To' other website searches for users.
- These links GoTo the relevant website and place the search term in the search box with immediate results (where possible).
- These links can change on a regular basis.
- They are very handy when there are limited resources in a school.

- When clicking on a GoTo link this will open a new tab/window so you can go between screens if needed.
- Some GoTo links may need the search topic to be typed in e.g. some regional libraries...
